AMMUNITION:

4.5mm (.177)

5.6mm (.22)

RANGE DISTANCE: 10 meters

EQUIPMENT:

Type Air Rifle:

Any factory air rifle

ANY SIGHTS:

Telescopic or Metallic may be used.

TRIGGER:

Typical to the rifle and not subject to accidental discharge

FIRING POSITION:

Any standing position without artificial support. The rifle will be supported by the hands and one shoulder only. One hand must be forward of the pistol grip.

HOW TO SHOOT THE MATCH:

You are allowed to fire two shots at the sighter target and one shot at each fly. No penalties will be recorded if there are less than 22 shots on the target, however the target will be disqualified if more than 22 shots appear on the target. Shooters have 20 minutes to complete the match.

HOW TO SCORE YOUR FLY:

Complete removal of head only:

5 points

Complete removal of rear body only:

4 points

Shot through wing: Removal of one or more legs: 3 points 2 points

Touching the fly silhouette anywhere: 1 point

Two shots on a single fly:

0 points

TIES:

Should a tie occur, the competitor with the greatest number of heads will receive the higher position. If the tie remains, the greater number of body hits will be used and so on through Wing Hits, Leg and to Fly Silhouette until a clear winner appears.

If a tie occurs, and if the outback still does not break the tie, then at the option and discretion of the Jury, the competitors may be required to shoot at any 5 fly targets. Firing will be in 5 shot series for each competitor and the highest score will determine the winner.
