

## **SSAA (Qld) Long Range Precision Team Selection Policy**

### Selection Criteria:

The State Discipline Chairman must submit a Team selected according to the Selection Criteria to the SSAA (Qld) Executive Committee for approval. The selection is to be based on merit and must be approved by SSAA (Qld) Executive Committee.

To qualify for a SSAA (Qld) Team a person must be a current financial member of SSAA (Qld) Inc.

### Discipline Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on the top Centrefire Team placings at an annual SSAA (Qld) Long Range Precision Championship, which must have competitors from a minimum of two SSAA (Qld) Branches.

As the discipline is a one where shooters work in teams of two as the spotter/coach for each other, both Team Members must be attending the SSAA Long Range Precision National Championship. If one Team Member cannot participate at the National Championship, that team will not be eligible for selection.

Members selected as the SSAA (Qld) Team must be registered as a Team and work together as a Team for the SSAA National Long Range Precision Championship.

Any SSAA (Qld) Long Range Precision Championship may be used as a selection shoot. If the SSAA (Qld) Long Range Precision Championship is held after the National Championship in the same calendar year, the previous year's State Championship will be used as the selection shoot. Any variation to this requires approval by the SSAA (Qld) State Executive.

There is no guarantee that a SSAA (Qld) Team will be selected to a Long Range Precision National Championship.

All SSAA (Qld) Teams are subject to the approval by the SSAA (Qld) State Executive, and discipline funding.

A competitor must indicate their acceptance or rejection of their team position within two weeks of being officially informed of their eligibility by the State Discipline Chairman. Any variation to this requires approval by the SSAA (Qld) Discipline Coordinator.

The Team Selection should be completed by the SSAA (Qld) Long Range Precision Discipline Chairman as soon as possible after their SSAA (Qld) Long Range Precision Championship and submitted to the SSAA (Qld) Executive Committee for approval.

All Team Members selected must be approved by the SSAA (Qld) Executive Committee before the selection process is complete.
